Member Benefits

Programming and Leagues

- Professionally managed by PrimeTime Sports offering multiple division leagues for ALL LEVELS OF PLAY
- Post season competition format via Team and NPL League based qualifiers into US Club's Regional/National Cup (team based) and NPL Playoffs (league based)
- OPC State Cup offering multiple divisions
- League programming opportunities for Boys/Girls U9-U19 with multiple divisions that allow for roster flexibility and "playing up" for development
- Coordinated calendar with proper periodization and year round leagues
- OPC will integrate Futsal programming into the Master Calendar

Player Development and Opportunities

- ODP will be offered as part of US Club's ID2/PDP ODP programs
- OPC Scouting Network comprised of coaches from all OPC member clubs
- OPC College and Professional preparation and ID programs
- OPC believes for player development reasons there should be 2-3 quality training sessions per every meaningful game therefore weeknight matches will be minimized.
- Futsal programming will be integrated into the master calendar as an added element to player development

- OPC Strategic Technical Board – program decisions are made by soccer professionals placing an emphasis on what's best for player development

Coach Development

- Coaches have opportunities to enroll in USSF National License courses

- Coaches will also attend a planned **OPC Coaching Symposium** for networking, education sessions with guest coaches, recognition and sharing best practices across OPC.



Referee Development

- Referee certification courses on East and West side will be offered
- Referee assignors work collectively as a team for OPC programming
- Referees may participate in a OPC Referee Development Academy offering special courses, assessments, etc. for OPC member referees

Facilities

- OPC member clubs have access to the best and largest home club complexes in Oklahoma
- Access to professionally operated complexes for OPC events

Tournaments

- OPC Member hosted tournaments will be sanctioned through US Club Soccer and be completely open and fully insured for all US Youth, USSSA or US Club teams to participate
- No travel permission required for any teams participating in a OPC/US Club sanctioned tournament

Club Membership

OPC is a club-based platform where members must meet certain standards. Interested clubs wishing to become a member may apply. Clubs are selected by the OPC Technical Leadership Board using the following criteria:

- 1) OPC must be their primary competitive platform
- 2) Quality of facilities
- 3) Size of club, quality of Competitive teams and Juniors/Academy programs
- 4) Quality of leadership and coaching staff
- 5) Administrative capabilities
- 6) Club structure, vision and development philosophy
- 7) Geographic consideration
